



Activity Name: Leadership Through Contemporary Art

Objective: Using artwork to teach leadership utilizes individuals' affective domain, which includes emotions of the heart. This tool can garner responses and reinforce emotional ties to artwork and to leadership in a contemporary way.

Audience: Can be tailored to work with any age group or professional background.

- Time Required: session can be formatted to be from 15 minutes through 2 hours depending on the artwork used.

Materials Needed/Setup: projector, laptop

Process: Participants will view a variety of artwork all meant to elicit specific emotions which relate to leadership theory

Facilitator Tips: Important to establish a good rapport with participants to create an environment where everyone is comfortable sharing their thoughts and perspectives on the artwork

Variations: Can be varied by artwork for different theories to emphasize different aspects.
